DRESS CODE

The staff at Newcomer welcomes your support in sending students to school clean, neat and dressed in school-appropriate clothing. Personal hygiene, good grooming and good manners enhance a person's success.

- Pants, dresses, shorts, skirts, and skorts are appropriate for school. All clothing must ensure that skin is covered down to the fully extended fingertips
 - -All of the above must be worn at the waist
 - -If jeans have rips or tears above the fingertips, the skin must be completely covered
 - -If skirts or dresses have slits, skin must be covered to the fingertips
- Shirts, sweatshirts, hoodies blouses, and tops are appropriate for school.
 - -No low cut necklines, exposed midriffs or open backs
 - -No sleeveless shirts or tops
 - -Hoods must be down and remain off the head for the entire school day
- Headwear and hats (other than traditional religious apparel) are to be stored in the locker for the entire school day
- Headbands and scarves must be less than three inches wide (other than traditional religious apparel)
- Outerwear designed for inclement weather are to be stored in the locker for the entire school day. This includes coats, scarves, gloves, hats and umbrellas.
- School issued IDs must be visible at all times
