Uniform Policy

Pants

Solid colors only:

Tan/Khaki, Black, Navy

- Uniform Style
- Corduroy is acceptable.
- No sagging
- No denim material/No jeans
- No sweatpants
- No jeggings
- No leggings worn as pants
- No logos

Shorts/Skirts or Jumpers

Solid colors only:

Tan/Khaki, Black, Navy

- No shorter than three inches above the knee
- No denim material/No jeans
- Leggings/Tights may be worn under jumpers/skirts.

Shirts

Any solid color

- Polo style, turtleneck, or button-down
- T-shirts with school logo
- All shirts must have short or long sleeves.
- Shirts must be tucked in.
- No logos
- On Fridays, students may wear a college shirt

Sweaters/Sweatshirts

Any solid color

- Pullover or cardigan (zippered or button-up/hoodies)
- No logos

Hijabs

Hijabs may be worn with the uniform.

Shoes

- Athletic or closed-toe/closed-heel only
- No sandals or heels
- No shoes with wheels (e.g., Heelies)

Cold-Weather Clothing

• Coats, thick/heavy jackets, gloves, hats, scarves, hoods, and any other cold-weather clothing are not to be worn within the classroom.

Dress Down Days

- No shorts shorter than three inches above the knee.
- No sleeveless shirts.
- No open toed shoes, clogs, or heelies
- Writing on shirts must be school appropriate

Jeans Days

- Jeans on bottom
- Uniform shirt on top

Jewelry/Purses

- Students are advised not to wear jewelry or carry purses during the day.
- Students will be directed to secure these items in a specific location (locker or classroom).

Policy Enforcement

- Students out of uniform will be sent to the Family Resource Center.
- Students are to change back into their original clothes prior to leaving for the day.
- For cases of repeat uniform infractions, the parent will be contacted.
- Contact the Family Resource Center coordinator if needing assistance with uniforms.
