

Wilder's New Dress Code

Students are expected to dress appropriately for school. Head coverings are not to be worn except for religious reasons. Coats are not to be worn in the classroom. Shorts and dresses must be worn below mid-thigh. Pants must be worn at the waist. No undergarments are to be exposed. Pant legs must not touch the ground. Shirts and blouses must have sleeves and may not expose the midriff in any way. No inappropriate messages or images are to be displayed on any clothing.

Because daily physical activity is a state requirement, students must wear shoes with closed toe and backs. No platform shoes or heels over one inch. No shoes with wheels, flip flops, sandals, clogs, jellies, or any shoes that would be unsafe for vigorous play are to be worn during the school day.

All jewelry and makeup is discouraged for students. If jewelry/makeup is worn, administrator will ask student to remove if it is deemed unsafe or interferes with classroom instruction. Administration has the final ruling if anything is questionable as to appropriateness or being unsafe.

Dress Code Violation Consequences

1st Consequence: Teacher/Staff discusses violation with student and a form is sent home and parent is required to sign.

2nd Consequence: A violation form is sent home, parent signs, and administrative staff makes phone call home.

3rd Consequence: The parent/guardian is called to bring a change of clothing. A conference takes place with parent/guardian and administrator to address the problem.
