

## **Butler Traditional High School Dress Code 2021-22 (updated 7/30/2021)**

Butler Traditional High School is a District Wide Magnet School. As a choice school, we consider appropriate attire and appearance to be directly correlated with academic success. We feel it is necessary to provide specific guidelines for students to follow and parents/guardians to support. We trust these guidelines will be regarded by all in the spirit in which they are intended. The dress code is not an attempt to deny anyone's religious or cultural heritage; however, since fashion changes frequently, individual circumstances will be addressed as the need arises.

### **Dress Code Standards**

The following guideline applies for Butler Traditional High School students and for students representing BTHS in any activity as a member of a team or organization. All students will follow the dress code listed below.

**Students who come to school violating the BTHS dress code will not be allowed to attend class or circulate through the school until their attire is corrected. Detention, ISAP, and other consequences may be assigned as disciplinary measures.**

**\*\*All Dress Codes are at the discretion of the administration\*\***

**\*\*All 3<sup>rd</sup> party vendor items using Butler Name and Logo must be approved by Administration\*\***

### **Shirts:**

- Polo shirts (long or short sleeve) with 3-5 buttons in solid colors of red or white (no stripes of any kind, anywhere on the shirt). Small logos are allowed on the left chest area only. No banded bottoms, snaps or zippers. Polo Shirts must be tucked in at all times and fit appropriately.
- Butler approved T-shirts (school issued, purchased through Butler High Campus store, or purchased through school fundraiser) may be worn each day. T-shirts do not need to be tucked in.
- Only Red or White long sleeve T-shirts (plain) may be worn under polo shirts.

**Slacks:** Only uniform slacks in solid colors of khaki (tan) or black. No lycra, any type of stretch material or form fitting allowed. No corduroy or capri slacks allowed. No jean look-alikes are allowed. Slacks need to be the correct size in both the waist and length. No pants are allowed that are sagging or that have been cut up the seam. Draw string pants will **not** be allowed. **No elastic on ankles – No yoga, spandex, or sweat pants. Slacks must be the proper size and worn at the waist line (No sagging).**

**Shorts:** **No shorts** will be allowed.

**Skirts:** **No skirts** will be allowed, unless administrator exemption is applied for and approved.

**Sweaters:** **No sweaters** of any type may be worn.

**Sweatshirts, Pullovers, Quarter Zip:** Butler High Campus store issued or team issued approved by administration (only Butler sweatshirts, pullovers, or quarter zip may be worn). **No Hoodies.** If a student removes a sweatshirt, they must be in dress code.

**Shoes:** Oxfords, athletic, loafers, boat shoes, toms or flats, crocs with back strap. Whole foot, toe and heel must be covered.

**Note:** No sandals, flip flops, slippers, house shoes, clogs, or mules.

**Piercings:** No cuffs, gauges or bars allowed in ears. One piercing in the nose is allowable but it must be a "stud" or "small hoop ring"

**Outerwear:** All Outerwear (jackets, coats, vests) and all headwear must be removed within the building. Outerwear may be worn, removed upon arrival, and stored in the locker in the morning. Outerwear may be carried to the student's last class, but may not be worn in class. **Note:** Butler jackets/wind suit jackets may be worn (no hoods).

**Hair/Personal Grooming:** Hair must be well-groomed and well-kept. Hair must be a natural hair color for both males and females.

- No unnatural hair colors (e.g. pink, green, blue, etc.)
  - *When hair color is addressed, parent will be notified and student will be given a time frame to comply with the dress code requirement.*

**Shaving:** Facial hair is allowed. Mustaches, goatees and beards must be well-groomed and well-kept.

**The Dress Code prohibits the following in the building:** Clothing of any type that is vulgar, attention getting, or distracting. Clothing with hand-painted or unauthorized designs; Clothing that is torn, has holes, patches. Oversized necklaces and charms; hats, caps, scarves, gloves, and sunglasses, winter head bands, ear warmers, hoods, and bandanas; and clothing representing other schools.

**Masks:** Facial masks covering the nose and mouth are required on the bus and in classrooms and during all transitions to and from locations in the building including arrival and dismissal, cafeteria, and hallway class changes (duration is determined by the JCPS Board of Education).

- Cloth masks must be plain, one solid color without any graphics or writing on the mask. School-issued masks with the official school logos are permissible. All masks must comply with the school dress code.
- Medical style disposable masks are also acceptable if they are plain and without graphics or writing.
- Bandanas are not approved face masks
- Administration shall have final authority to determine the suitability of any face covering.
